CEO REMARKS

As philanthropists we must always be asking ourselves how we can do better.

Since our inception in 2014, like many philanthropists, our focus was mostly on granting. We knew women were the most effective change agents so we supported economic empowerment and education programs for women and girls in the Asia Pacific region via large multi-year grants through trusted organisations.

But ultimately, it wasn't enough. We knew we could do more. We asked ourselves hard questions and looked at all our available resources critically. We identified many opportunities to do better;

1 By redirecting our corpus to only investments with a positive impact.

- 2 By granting to support advocacy work, capacity building and via concessional loans.
- 3 By opening up our office space and attached accommodation to share with our partners.
- 4 By changing how we identify the issues that need our support, no longer a top down approach but by asking the recipients of our funding what their needs are.
- 5 Acknowledging that we are the mere facilitators of change, the real change makers are those that do the work.

So we are no longer a traditional foundation. We are now an impact group.

Whether through our grants program or our investments, we seek to partner with real visionaries to address inequality and disadvantage in our region.

So in 2021 we are proud to launch our new vision. An annual \$1 million award through our B.I.G. Change program. Our younger generation's grants program focuses solely on the climate crisis - B.I.G. Future. Continuing our work of using all our capital for social change via B.I.G. Investments, and launching our B.I.G. ideas program which is about transparency, sharing, openness and collaboration.

As our new logo symbolizes we are only one small drop, but one drop can be the cause of a giant ripple of change.

Our founder, Bev Barlow said, it is self-improvement that leads to selfempowerment. She also said "Just get on with it." So we are.

So, let's do it better. And let's do it B.I.G.

OUR HISTORY

The Barlow Impact Group has grown out of the Barlow Foundation which was seed funded by Beverley Barlow with \$20 million in 2014.

The beginning

Bev Barlow began her working life as a teacher in Papua New Guinea. After Bev met Doug in Canada, they moved to Melbourne and ran the family grocery store in Richmond. From humble beginnings the family grew the business and today own over 700 stores and coffee shops and are one of the largest family-owned companies in Australia.

The foundation is born

Between 2014-2019 the Barlow Foundation delivered \$4.3 million in grants to charitable organisations that fostered selfreliance and self-empowerment in women and children from disadvantaged backgrounds. During this period the Barlow Foundation granted to more than 30 not for profit organisations and invested quadruple that in social change making impact investments.





GRANTING FOR CHANGE

Historically, The Barlow Foundation's granting program was guided by the research in the book Half The Sky, the authors clearly build the case that it is women who are the most effective change agents. We therefore focused on female education programs (60%), the economic empowerment of women (31%), law and justice (2%) and other discretionary giving (7%) through large multi-year partnerships.

Beverley and Douglas Barlow have lived their lives with kindness, integrity, hard work and generosity. We are proud to continue and grow this tradition through the work of the Barlow Impact Group.

B.I.G. is revolutionising Australian philanthropy by leveraging all our available capital to support those who share its vision to create equal opportunity for all.

We acknowledge that it is those that are doing the work that can best identify the problems and know the solutions. We want to listen to the needs of those at the front line and facilitate their work and their needs with our funding.

The Barlow Impact Groups' grants program has been designed to accelerate positive change in the world. We award an annual grant of \$1 million to back big-hearted change makers with solutions to fix entire systems and reduce inequalities in Australia, South East Asia or the Pacific.

B.I.G. Future is the annual granting program led by the younger generation of the Barlow family, dedicated to finding solutions to the climate crisis.

Facing the biggest challenge of our generation, we believe the solutions to combat climate change already exist, and we want to support the global movement toward a sustainable future.

Getting from 51 billion tonnes of greenhouse gases every year to net-zero is no small task, but together, it's possible.

In 2016, B.I.G. made the decision to commit to 100% impact/ Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) exposure in order to leverage the overall power of the capital base. This enables us to have the greatest possible impact.

Between 2014 and 2019, the Barlow Impact Group grew ESG and impact investments from 2% to 93%.

Our commitment is that 100% of our corpus will be invested for social impact through impact investments, ESG investments and concessional loans.

Through our investment portfolio we have supported life changing initiatives, including social justice reform, building hospitals and green buildings, alternative energy sources, education apps and services and access to low-cost medicines and financial services.
